Below are the outlined expectations of the Ainslie Football Club Men's Senior Assistant, as discussed:

Match Day

- Attend all Senior matches unless discussed otherwise with Senior Coach
- Provide Senior Coach with coaching support including game plan decisions, player positions and in game scenarios
- Provide feedback to players and other coaches in high pressure situations
- Contribute to team success through game analysis (statistics), individual performance analysis and team performance
- Attend reserve grade games when applicable
- Ability to think critically in high pressure situations

Training Nights

- Attend Tuesday and Thursday night training sessions to provide support to Senior Coach
- Plan and execute drills based on the session focus areas and outcomes
- Optional attendance at Senior Match Selection
- Ability to step in and run training in the absence of the Senior Coach
- Provide players with individual performance feedback through iSports and face to face discussions
